A very warm welcome to this coming season of lunchtime presentations at Leeds Town Hall.

It is our great pleasure at Leeds Town Hall to be able once again to host free Monday lunchtime concerts of organ, brass band and choral music between September and April.

A rich diversity of repertoire caters for a variety of tastes, and the programmes are well-contrasted to yield a wide range of sonorities – not least those from the Town Hall organ, one of the most comprehensive such instruments in Britain.

Additionally, there are 'discovery' mornings with armchair tours of the king of instruments for the young – and the young at heart. Among young artists appearing this season, we extend a very warm welcome to sopranos Sarah Potter and Helen Strange and to Hyang Hee Woo, winner of the Organ Prize at the Royal Northern College of Music in 2011.

Also playing in our series for the first time we are delighted to welcome Dr Gerald Gifford from Cambridge and, from St Albans, Tom Winpenny – a musician with significant Yorkshire roots.

Our choral programmes include a celebration of rare English music in honour of the Diamond Jubilee Year of Her Majesty The Queen featuring two West Riding-born composers, Halifax's Sir George Dyson and Dr George Oldroyd from Healey, near Batley.

Variety is again achieved by organ accompaniment to a silent film and by the solo contributions of Sally-Ann Shepherdson and Phillip McCann. Eagerly awaited will be visits from the University of Huddersfield Brass Band, The Choirs of Leeds Cathedral and Leeds Parish Church and St Peter's Singers. This year's Yorkshire Three Choirs Concert visits Leeds Parish Church.
